General operations update	Matt has stepped back from the Quarry Manager position and has taken the role of Maintenance Manager. Beau Patton has filled the role as Quarry Manager, and apologises for not being able to be here to introduce himself. He is looking forward to meeting everyone at our next meeting.  DA: The City of Gold Coast Council recently issued new conditions for Beenleigh Quarry, amending the Quarry's operating hours and replacing three (3) previous approvals that the site operates under, with a single approval.  Under the Planning Act 2016, the next stage of the Development Application

process involves a comprehensive review of the new conditions and identification of any further discussions required with Council before the new conditions are adopted. The date of formal adoption is currently unknown.

Council's endorsed temporary operating hours on Saturdays ceased on Saturday 2 December 2023. Holcim has made a further request for Saturday hours going forward while the Development Application is finalised.

Production will cease from Friday 22nd December at 1pm, and sales at 6pm. This will resume as per usual business, Monday 8th January 2024.

## **Environmental monitoring**

- All dust monitoring results from October 2023 to November 2023 were compliant with consent conditions
- All blast monitoring results from October 2023 November 2023 were compliant with consent conditions
- The blast on the 19th September exceeded the airover pressure (dbl) at the top of Vennor drive, an investigation was conducted by Orica and found no conclusive evidence as to the cause of the exceedance.
- 4 blasts were completed between the 19.9.23 28.11.23
