4	<u>Business Arising:</u> NA to write to the Department explaining the QPRC representative role. Compost/sludge Trial: The samples that were taken had slightly elevated copper and dieldrin. The compost can still be used a relatively good product, albeit non-compliant with AS4454:2012 Not to be used for home and gardens but public parks and garden beds is alright. They did not test the biosolids material prior to the trial, the best way forward to implement this composting process is to test and manage the inputs. VENM: DA approved for Quarry to take VENM. It is working OK with CIC sending out information in a circular. Charging small fee of \$6 per tonne. Staff check for quality. No contamination accepted. Keep topsoil and loamy material for rehabilitation works. Access Road - The purpose of the gate at that location is to prevent night time access, as there has been incidents of vandalism, car burning etc in the area. In addition, it was part of the contract of sale for the acquisition of the land from Mr Heffernan. The new street signs "Quarry Road" have been erected but the re-numbering is not complete yet.
